# Spider Multiplication

**Objective** Explore multiplication problems.

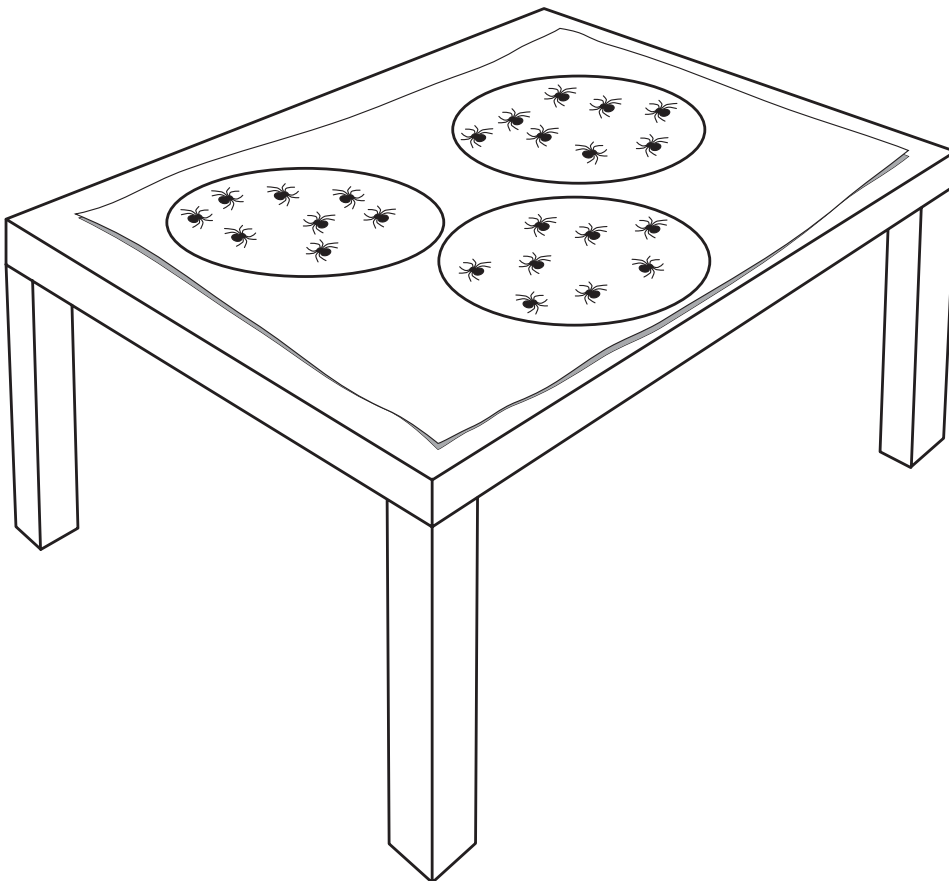
**What You Need** Marking pens (or colored magnetic marbles)  
Paper

**Safety** Follow your parent's or teacher's rules for safety.

**Directions** Draw several circles on a large piece of paper.

Then draw 8 spiders in each circle  
or use marbles to represent spiders.

One circle of 8 represents the multiplication problem  $1 \times 8 = 8$ ,  
two circles of 8 represent  $2 \times 8 = 16$ , etc.



Now try the multiplication chant.

$1 \times 8 = 8 \dots 2 \times 8 = 16 \dots 3 \times 8 = 24 \dots 4 \times 8 = 32 \dots 5 \times 8 = 40 \dots$   
 $6 \times 8 = 48 \dots 7 \times 8 = 56 \dots 8 \times 8 = 64 \dots 9 \times 8 = 72 \dots 10 \times 8 = 80 \dots$   
etc.
