



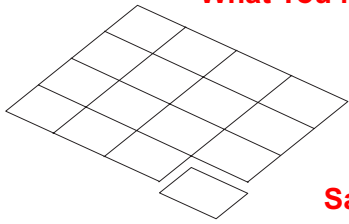
Activity 402 B Adaptations

Flipping Through a Web

Objective Use a flip book to describe how a spider spins an orb web.

What You Need

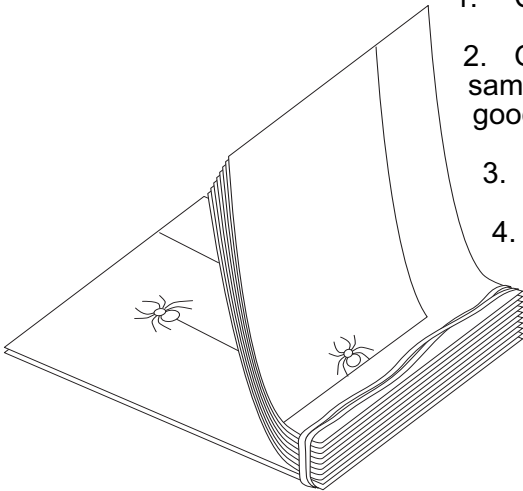
Scissors
Rubber band
Pencil
Glue
Index cards



Safety Follow your parent's or teacher's rules for safety.

Directions Make a flipbook using the templates provided or make one from scratch.

1. Cut out the pages of the flip book from the handouts.
2. Glue the pages onto index cards. Make sure that you glue them in the same spot on each of the index cards. The bottom right hand corner is a good spot.
3. Stack the index cards in order from 1 to 32.
4. Rubber band the index cards tightly together at the top.
5. Flip the pages of your book. The spider will crawl down the page with its web line. When the spider reaches the center of the page, web lines will shoot out in all directions. The spider will make a circular or orb web.



- Go Further**
1. Make a list of the steps a spider follows in making a web.
 2. Try to weave your own web with a ball of string. Find a spot in your room that is out of the way of any heavy traffic and try to create your own web that would be able to catch your dinner!
